Major Types of Violations



Damaging, interfering with, cutting off, or making illegal use of public telecommunications networks; disrupting communications; or preventing the exchange of information in general



A service provider's failure to provide CITC with any report or information within its competence when so requested, as prescribed by the Regulations



Using or possessing any telecommunications device not authorized to be used by CITC



Importing, marketing, or using telecommunications devices or equipment that are inconsistent with the approved technical specifications



Creating, selling, promoting, or using prepaid calling cards in violation of the controls and instructions issued by the Board Declining to implement a decision issued by CITC against a person against whom a violation is alleged;

said decision shall include the written directive issued by a competent official at CITC
