

50. ISDN SERVICE *

Integrated Digital Subscriber Line (ISDN) service is a PSTN service which provides integrated voice and data communication over the same line. The service has two options, a 64 Kb/s Basic Rate Access (BRA) with 2 channels, and a 2 Mb/s Primary Rate Access (PRA) with 30 channels.

10.6 UNIVERSAL ACCESS NUMBER (UAN) SERVICE

UAN Service provide subscribers with a universal number to use within the country. The service permits caller to call a universal national number for a local call charge (when using the PSTN) or the mobile call charge (when using the mobile network). The UAN subscriber (the called party) pays for any difference between the charges for the call (which may be a national call) and the local call rate paid by the caller if the call is made from a PSTN telephone. In the case of the call being made from a mobile telephone, the subscriber will not incur any charge. International calls will also not be charged to the subscriber.
